

CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

The Trustees understand the necessity of avoiding their decisions being influenced by any conflicts of interest between individual Trustees and the Charity.

Although the Charity's Articles do allow for the possibility of Trustees benefitting from the Charity in very specific circumstances and under very strict conditions, in practice Trustees are not paid for their services to the Charity, nor do they derive benefit from the work of the Charity.

Individual Trustees are required to absent themselves from any discussions where it is possible that a conflict will arise between his or her duty to act solely in the interests of the Charity and any personal interest (including but not limited to any personal financial interest).
